Story

Logline:

Short Synopsis:

A tumultuous flat party, serving as an expression of their inner conflicts, marks the end of a day for three flatmates at an emotional crossroad: Tommy, a lost soul, fights against the shadows of his past and has to confront his brother Ben. Lea desperately grapples with her love for Ellie, while Rosa embarks on the painful journey of self-discovery to escape her family's expectations. After a day full of revelations and decisions, they face the ultimate question: Do they dare to leap into the unknown or remain trapped within the familiar yet suffocating confines of their lives?



Long Synopsis:

Amidst the chaos of a lively flat party, serving as the backdrop, the destinies of three flatmates are illuminated. As they reunite amidst the pulsating atmosphere of the celebration, they engage in an emotional dialogue with the events of their day, attempting to clarify their desires and fears. Tommy, a lost soul, confronted with the shadows of his past, must confront his feelings towards his brother Ben. Lea desperately struggles with her love for Ellie, with whom she has been stuck in a "situationship" for months. Meanwhile, Rosa embarks on the painful journey of self-discovery to escape her family's expectations. Amidst the laughter and conversations of the party, they search for answers to the pressing questions of their lives. Amidst the music and drinks, they face the ultimate question: Do they dare to leap into the unknown or remain trapped within the familiar yet suffocating confines of their lives?



Motivation

"Short Stories from the Third Floor" presents a powerful portrayal of individuals grappling with personal challenges and inner conflicts. It offers a candid depiction of human experiences that are likely familiar to many viewers from their own lives or immediate surroundings.

The starting point was the desire to create a work that stimulates reflection and inspires overcoming one's own fears and uncertainties. Mental health, the need for intimacy and anxieties about the future are central themes. Through a sincere portrayal of these themes, a dialogue is initiated and awareness of the complexity of the human emotional spectrum is heightened. The decision to adopt an episodic narrative style underscores this diversity of emotions.

In "Short Stories from the Third Floor," characters like Lea, Rosa and Tommy serve as a starting point for the audience to engage with their own emotions and those of their environment, rather than concealing them behind a facade as society often expects.

Director's statement

"The film revolves around the lives of young people and their often unspoken problems. The focus of the film lies on the characters we follow over the course of a day and their experiences. During the writing process, I delved deeply into the thoughts and concerns of people in der 20s to tell an authentic and relatable story. In quiet moments, we take the time to understand the characters and empathize with them. The emphasis is not on over-dramatized scenes, but on telling a relatable and genuine story that encourages thought and reflection."



Characters

Rosa

The Colombian, Rosa, embodies a sense of responsibility and diligence. Her lively temperament and emotional nature occasionally lead to impulsive actions. Although naturally extroverted, she exhibits caution and restraint towards strangers. She values social interaction greatly and desires to be liked, though not necessarily to be the center of attention. Self-determined and independent, Rosa knows exactly what she wants.

Lea

Lea embodies a vibrant personality, steadfast in her belief in the power of love and always eager to discover the goodness in life. She balances her natural naivety and occasional clumsiness with a charming and humorous demeanor. Despite her ability to conceal it well, she harbors a deeply vulnerable side.

Tommy

Tommy is of a quiet and introverted nature, often lost in his thoughts. However, his reserve conceals a profound and empathetic character. Even when inwardly tense, he sometimes displays his humorous and affectionate nature. With his gentle and contemplative demeanor, Tommy becomes a valuable friend.

Lars Nover

Margit Mägdefrau is a passionate actress who gravitates towards emotionally resonant roles, drawing from a versatile acting repertoire and experiences from an unconventional life. Her authenticity makes her a captivating artist.

Currently, she is working as his personal assistant alongside director Brian Kirk (Game of Thrones) with actors such as Judy Greer, Emma Thompson, and Marc Menchaca, learning from seasoned industry giants. Her thirst for knowledge and curiosity ensure that she continuously acquires new skills. This has led her into the world of voice acting, where she has contributed to renowned series like "Spinning Out" on Netflix and "Amphibia" on Disney.

Beyond acting, she boasts an impressive professional career. At 30 years old, she is not only a trained scientist but also an experienced filmmaker.



Patrick Ehler

Patrick Christopher Ehler, born in 1988 in Augsburg, is a versatile actor, creative director and author with language skills in German, English and Portuguese.

His appearance in "The Young Americans" marked his entry into the industry, followed by his participation in the "Art Basel Hong Kong" in 2016. Patrick has been involved in various film projects, including "Girl You Know It's True", "Herrhausen" and the "Disney Road Show." In 2021, he appeared in the series "Sturm der Liebe" and is part of the ensembles of "Magic in the Maze" and "The Blessing."

In addition to his work as a lecturer at the "SIYLI" Institute and mentor at the University of Applied Sciences FHM, Patrick founded an association for emotional intelligence in 2020 and published a workbook for the education sector in 2022. With a commitment to his own continuous education, he collaborates with renowned acting coaches and is a member of various acting associations.

Danixa Urbano

The search for the perfect cast of Rosa took some time. Danixa Urbano was suggested by a crew member and, after getting to know each other and rehearsing with the director, proved to be the perfect fit. With "Short Stories from the Third Floor," she makes her debut as an actress.



Christina Andrione

Born in 1967 in Munich as a child of Brazilian descent, Cristina began her acting career in 1996 by passing the ZAV stage proficiency examination. Over decades, she continuously invested in her education, including vocal and camera training.

In addition to numerous theater engagements, she is known for various TV productions such as "Um Himmels Willen," "Die Rosenheim-Cops," and "Hubert und Staller." Her supporting role in the Netflix series "Biohackers" from 2019 to 2020 solidified her reputation in the industry.

Guido Broscheit

Born in May 1968, the actor is known for numerous TV productions such as "Notruf Hafenkante," "Rote Rosen" and "Sturm der Liebe". He began his career with various training courses in 2006 and made his debut as a supporting actor in the feature film "Die Dinge zwischen uns" in 2007. He went on to appear in further projects such as "Ronny & Klaid", "An Eye for Revenge" and starred in "The Yellow Tie" in 2023 alongside Sean Bean and John Malkovich. Since the founding of his company "Dropkick Pictures" in 2017, he has also works as a producer.

Before dedicating himself to acting, he completed studies in law at Münster and Lausanne and has been a qualified lawyer since 1998. He practiced this profession until 2006.

Tamara Roming

The aspiring actress Tamara Roming, born in 1995 in Landsberg am Lech, not only completed training as a musical performer but also attended acting school. After her first leading role in the unfinished film "The Run" in 2017, she had diverse engagements, including appearances in the Schwarzwald crime series, the ZDF series "Der Alte," and the FilmFernsehFonds Bayern supported feature film "Rogue Trader."

Her breakthrough came in 2023 with the titular role in the feature film "The Dark Girl," which was honored with the prestigious Camgaroo Award at the Munich Film Festival. In her latest project, the two-part series "Schneekind", she not only had the opportunity to act alongside Uschi Glas but also showcased her impressive vocal talent.

Jessica Lissok

Even before her training from 2018 to 2021 at Questors Theatre London, Jessica gained initial attention through her leading role in the short film "Anke" in 2008. A year later, the 1992-born actress and narrator, continued this debut in "Anke – The Return."

Her talent was once again showcased in the short film "Not Like You," presented at the Max Ophüls Festival in 2021, where she impressed with her role as Linda.

This also gave her comprehensive insights into the financing and marketing of fictional projects.

Simultaneously she realised, together with André J. Witt, the medium-length film "Another Way to Make a Living" as a producer, which premiered in 2022 and had great sponsors such as QNAP, Seagate and Kamerapool. In autumn 2023, she worked as a line producer on the elaborate fantasy diploma project "Daemonicon" at the Film Academy Baden-Württemberg, supported by Wiedemann & Berg.

For "Short Stories from the Third Floor" - her feature film debut as a producer - she managed to attract renowned sponsors such as ARRI and Kamerapool for the project. Completion is planned for the summer of 2024.

Currently, she is working as the personal assistant to director Brian Kirk (Game of Thrones, 21 Bridges) for the project "The Fisherwoman," starring Emma Thompson, Judy Greer and Marc Menchaca, to gain unique experiences for her own work as a producer.

This versatile professional journey not only reflects Margit's understanding of different areas of film production but also underscores her continuous learning and development.

His journey led him to the Academy for Communication in Stuttgart, where he successfully completed his training with a focus on film and video. During this time, he began working as a freelance videographer, producing touching image films.

After graduation, André immersed himself in the world of film, writing scripts and directing various projects. His passion drove him to study books and acquire extensive technical knowledge, particularly in cinematography. He spent hours analyzing films to understand what makes them successful and how they touch the audience.

In 2018, André realised his medium-length film "Another Way to Make a Living" as a writer and director, which allowed him to mature as an artist. In 2022, the film was successfully released by UCM.one and is now available on various streaming platforms and Condor flights.

His stories are characterized by emotional depth and often packaged in genre films. As a director, he takes time to give the characters space, telling stories slowly and empathetically to establish a strong connection with the audience and offer a different perspective on poignant themes.
